

## INVESTOR OVERVIEW

The Flywheel Fund is a member-managed VC fund, where accredited investors pool their money to invest in early-stage tech startups based in Indiana. Investors invest annually in a fund that pools money to make monthly investments in **Indiana-based** tech companies. **No** prior investing experience is required, but investors must be accredited (as defined by the SEC) and can invest as little as \$10,000. Flywheel's structure is unique in that it:



Provides support to the local startup ecosystem by investing in local and regional companies



Facilitates connections to other local investors



Educates new investors about the angel investing process



Provides venture returns and diversification, all at a comparatively low entry cost.



## **HOW IT WORKS**

Flywheel vets and selects one startup to pitch each month

Members meet monthly, via Zoom, to hear a pitch and receive due diligence prior to meeting

Each pitch is followed by a O&A with the founder and a private discussion among members

At the end of the pitch, each member votes whether or not they wish to invest

When the majority votes "yes", the group invests as a whole
